- The Sheraton Grand Conakry is financed by the International Finance Corporation (IFC) and the Dutch Development Bank (FMO)
- Topaz Group terminated the two union delegates with the collaboration of the Labor Inspector under the previous presidential administration
- The arbitrary termination of union delegates is a violation of workers' freedom of association rights
