## CONCERNS: RE: COVID-19 INFORMATION AND RESOURCES FOR IUF AFFILIATES

Following the e-mail circular of March 24, 2020 relative to the above subject matter, we wish to post the following news and information as the impact of COVID-19 on the IUF sector in Ghana:

- 1. All Hotels have been closed down
- 2. Employers of the Hotels in a form of cartel want to graduate downwards salaries of April, May and June, 2020 by 75%, 50%, 30% and 20% respectively.
- 3. Presently we are engaging the employers on how to protect jobs and lives. We will communicate outcome shortly.
- 4. Government has given Three Billion Ghana Cedis as a loan with minimum interest to support the Hotel Industry.
- Regular workers are still at post at the hotels, though no work is going on. Casuals numbering 2,400 have been laid off (though they are not members of the Union).
- 6. Agric Sector All workers of the Agric Sector are working but observing social distance. However, productivity has declined.
- 7. Government has given support to the entire country with 50% water and electricity payment cut for three months, i.e. April to June, 2020.
- 8. Public and civil servants will be paid their full salary up to June, 2020.
- 9. Restaurants have suffered major blow as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
