## STATEMENT ON THE REFUGEE CRISIS

Faced with the tragedy of refugees fleeing war, oppression and exploitation for safety in Europe, the worker representatives in the Nestlé European Works Council and their unions:

**Recalling** the values of unity, solidarity and compassion which underpin the trade union movement:

**Recalling** the central role of trade unions in promoting equity, fairness and inclusiveness:

**Condemn** measures that endanger human dignity and physical integrity and violate human rights;

**Condemn**, in this regard, the construction of walls, fences and other disgraceful barriers:

**Condemn** the manifestations of ethnic and religious hatred, the manipulation of public opinion and the spreading of disinformation for political gain which have accompanied the refugee crisis;

**Reject** intolerance and anti-immigrant sentiment;

**Underline** that we are called on as European citizens to assist refugees, to offer them asylum and a chance at a future;

**Underline** our shared values as workers and trade unionists and **undertake** to give wide publicity to this statement in our unions and workplaces.

We call on our unions to increase efforts to organize and defend the rights of migrant workers.
